### I spy

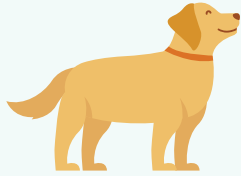
What can you spy on your way to school? Write or draw your answers.

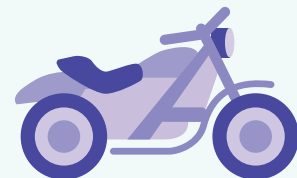

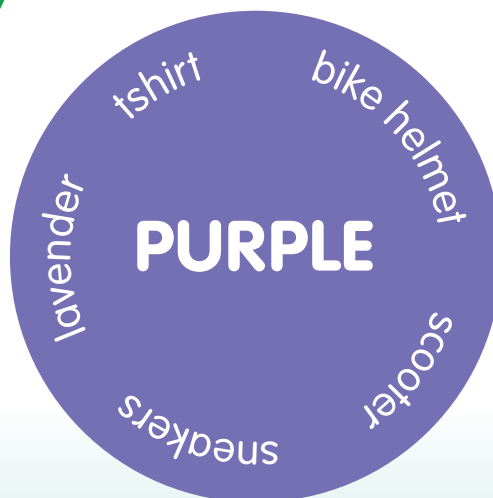
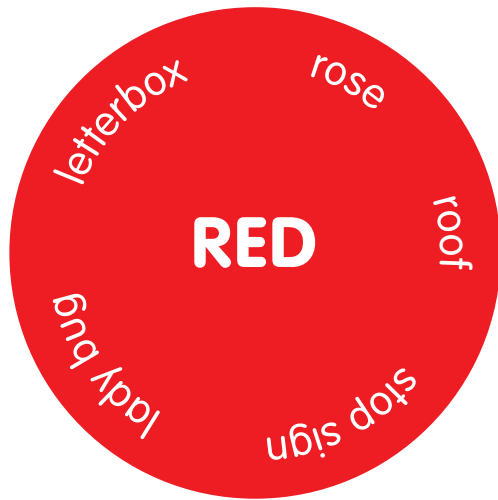

Can you hear a door close?



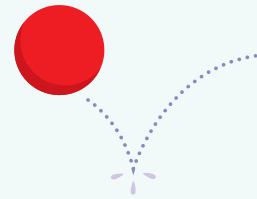

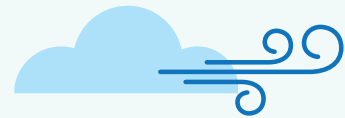
