

Resource 36: Companion Card

Facilities and activities are accessible: Welcome

Some people with a disability will require a carer to attend an event with them. Charging two admission fees is a discriminatory practice as it doubles the cost of attending for the person with a disability.

The Companion Card is a scheme designed to ensure fairer ticketing practices for people with a disability. The companion of a cardholder should be admitted to an event at no charge. Recognising the Companion Card is one way to increase the inclusion of people with a disability as spectators to your sport.
