VicHealth – Who are we? What do we do?

- Established in 1987
- Focused on health promotion and prevention across five priority areas
- Vision is for a Victoria where everyone can experience better health and wellbeing
- Seek to address the determinants of health (e.g. income, education, employment, discrimination inequality)
- Take action in the places people live, work, learn and play – like sports, workplaces, media, schools
- Work with partners across many sectors and settings



6. You must comply with Working with Children legislation and data privacy requirements

- Outlined in appendix 1 of your letter of offer.

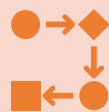
Other Key Requirements



Project delays - you **must** notify VicHealth in writing (partnershipgrants@vichealth.vic.gov.au)



Projects must be delivered between 1 July 2021 and 30 June 2022



If you **can't deliver** your project within the 12-months we ask that you please let us know as soon as you know.
