VicHealth – Who are we? What do we do?

- Established in 1987

- Work with partners across many sectors and settings



3. Submit your target population form

Sten 1: Click on 'My Reports' on the home screen of the nortal





2. Project reporting requirements

- Reports to be submitted in the Stakeholder Portal
 - Progress Report: due 19 November 2021
 - Final Report: due 21 May 2022
- Both reports are financial milestones with grant payments attached it's important that you submit on time.
- Instructions will be provided by VicHealth in advance of the due date

3. Participate in a Community of Practice

- Talk with, and learn from, other grant recipients
- Date to be confirmed and advised by VicHealth later in the year

4. Record Keeping

- Keep records for at least 7-years
- Records include
 - Financial records
 - Progress against milestones (e.g. reports)
 - Receipt and expenditure of funding
 - Creation of project material

5. Audit

- You may be asked to participate.
- An audit allows us to see how our money is being used in the community to improve the health and wellbeing of Victorians.

6. Financial acquittals

- You will be required to report on how you spent project funds, make sure you keep receipts.
- A financial officer from your organisation is required to sign off on your acquittal
- An acquittal template and instructions will be provided in 2022
- This is your final milestone due in June 2022. Template will be provided.

7. Be able to participate in an evaluation led by VicHealth if requested

• We may undertake an evaluation up to 18-months post completion

8. Working with Children and Insurance Requirements

• Does you project involve children under 18-years of age? Please note there is a requirement to obtain **Working with Children Checks**, as outlined in item 11 of your Funding Agreement.

- Insurance details to be uploaded to the Stakeholder Portal:
 - Certificate of Currency for **public liability insurance** of at least \$2,000,000
 - Certificate of Currency for Workers Compensation (WorkCover) or letter from WorkSafe providing an exemption
 - Instructions on submitting Insurance details can be found on page 13-19 of the guidelines <u>available here</u>

Other Key Requirements



Project delays - you **must** notify VicHealth in writing (partnershipgrants@vichealth.vic.gov.au)



Projects must be delivered between 1 July 2021 and 30 June 2022



If you can't deliver your project within the 12-months we ask that you please let us know as soon as you know.
