

### Did you find the incursion to be engaging for the children?




"A lot of children were very excited to eat their sushi and their vegetables because they MADE it."

**Figure 1:** Represents how engaged the educators felt the children were during the incursion

- 1 out of 3 centres were likely to book another incursion in the next term
- 2 out of 3 centres would book another incursion within the next year

**Figure 2:** Shows the likelihood of centres booking another incursion with Foost and in what time period.

- 100% OF RESPONDERS GAINED INSPIRATIONS TO DO MORE COOKING AND FOOD PREP WITH THE CHILDREN AFTER ENGAGING IN THE INCURSION
- PARTICIPANTS WERE HIGHLY LIKELY TO RECOMMEND THE FOOST INCURSION TO A COLLEAGUE, WITH AN AVERAGE WEIGHING OF 4.5% OUT OF 5.
- EDUCATORS FELT THAT THE INCURSION ADDRESSED AND FURTHER SUPPORTED HEALTHY EATING PROGRAMS ALREADY IMPLEMENTED WITHIN THEIR CENTRE.
