VICHEALTH AWARD FINALISTS - VICTORIA'S HEALTH PROMOTION TRAILBLAZERS REVEALED

The 59 finalists in the 2019 VicHealth Awards were revealed today, showcasing the trailblazing health promotion work happening across Victoria.

VicHealth CEO Dr Sandro Demaio said the quality and breadth of the finalists helping Victorians to live healthier, happier lives is astounding.

"This was my first year being involved with the VicHealth Awards, and the incredible diversity of the finalists was fantastic to see," Dr Demaio said.

"Regardless of your gender, age, ethnicity, sexuality or where you live – everyone should be able to live a happy, healthy life – and I really believe this year's finalists speak to that."

2019 saw the largest number of finalists ever in a VicHealth Awards, with an increase of over 50% in total nominations received.

"I commend every one of the 59 finalists for making it to this stage, and I can't wait to acknowledge and celebrate with all the finalists at the VicHealth Awards Ceremony on 3 December."

The VicHealth Awards are the state's highest accolade for health promotion, recognising the efforts of local grassroots projects to state-wide campaigns and everything in between.
